### **Feed the Hungry**

Community: • Gleaner Food Truck  
• Love Inc • Soup Kitchen

Church: • Food Pantry • Coffee & Doughnuts

Family: • Make dinner

### **Give Drink to the Thirsty**

Community: • Provide drinks for a 5K race

Church: • Coffee & Doughnuts

Family: • Make coffee for parents

### **Clothe the Naked**

Community: • Donate clothes from closet

Church: • Contribute to Haiti ministry

Family: • Help with laundry  
• Help younger siblings get dressed

### **Shelter the Homeless**

Community: • Love Inc • Habitat for Humanity

Church: • Contribute to Haiti ministry

Family: • Help sibling clean room • Help with house cleaning/ yardwork • Babysit for free

### **Care for the Sick**

Community: • Visit a Nursing Home  
• Visit a family member or friend who is sick

### **Instruct the Ignorant**

Community: • Tutor someone

Church: • Vacation Bible School  
• Children's Liturgy of the Word

### **Counsel the Doubtful**

### **Admonish the Sinner**

Community/Church/Family:  
• Stand up to a bully

### **Bear Wrongs Patiently**
