Application Guidelines

1. Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application. Letters may be prepared by a parent, teacher, coach, parishioner, supervisor of a program, or ministry leader to name a few.
2. The Personal Statement of Intent is critical. This brief explanation (one paragraph) of your personal goal will be a primary factor in the selection committee’s decision. Additional information will include: 1) when the award payment is due and 2) how the award will impact the Mission, Vision and Core Values of the parish.
3. The fund is not intended to be a source of funding for college or catholic school tuition.
4. Applications must be received prior to the stated deadlines. Late applications will be forwarded for the next period.
5. Award recipients will be asked to send a follow-up report to the Parish Administrator as a testimony to the value of the award and progress of the participant.
6. Awards will be limited to one per applicant per year.
7. Awards will be limited to a range of \$900 to \$1200 per quarter by fiscal year.
8. Awards will be distributed proportionally per quarter among the selected applicants.
9. Applications are to be mailed to the Parish Office and to the attention of the Parish Administrator.
10. We are a Stewardship Parish; therefore applicants must be a registered member and active in the parish sharing their blessing of Time, Talent, and Treasure.
11. Applications are available in the Parish Office, Family Center and the parish website.
